Introduction (10%)

Start off by explaining what subject you are applying for and why.

Topic of interest/Academic interest (60%)

Talk in depth about what you enjoy about your chosen subject and why you want to take it further.

Super-curricular activities (10%)

Anything related to your course that you have done outside of school or college will massively boost your application e.g. Work experience, University lectures/taster sessions, related research projects.

Extra-curricular activities (10%)

This section will give the Admissions Officer a little more information about your personality and what you can contribute to university life. **Can you think of any extra-curricular activities which you have taken part in?**

e.g. Duke of Edinburgh, Part-time job, Music/debating/mentoring/school responsibilities/sports

What skills did you show? E.G Time management, organisation, communication, leadership.

Conclusion (10%)

Finish with a **strong** conclusion. Summing up why you want to study your chosen subject at University.
